ABOUT THE PROGRAM:

The goal of dental care is the preservation of the dentition. Dental extractions are a therapeutic procedure to treat severely damaged, non-restorable, periodontally hopeless, and impacted teeth. This course will describe a rising trend in bone grafting that recycles autologous extracted teeth that otherwise would have been disposed of, and now are used to graft alveolar bone defects.
