It is my honor to welcome you to the 2019-2020 year of our dental society! No matter how far removed from school I am, my years still feel like they run on the basis of a traditional school year. Instead of resolutions in January, I tend to set yearly intentions every September. If you are like me and are thinking about setting goals for this "school year," here are some ideas you might consider.

First, there continue to be many changes to Washington's dental practice and licensing requirements. I highly recommend subscribing to the WA Dental Quality Assurance Commission email list (https://public.govdelivery.com/accounts/WADOH/subscriber/new). You will receive information about rulemaking and other topics related to dental professionals. Currently, there are rules in progress regarding infection control, dental anesthesia, delegation to dental hygienists under general supervision, and specialty representation. Subscribing to their email list is an easy goal to accomplish and will help keep you informed on important changes that will affect your practice of dentistry.

Another easy goal is helping the Snohomish County Dental Foundation earn donations from corporations: 1) Use smile.amazon.com for Amazon purchases and delegate the Dental Foundation to receive a donation from Amazon of 0.5% of the price of eligible purchases. Since I have started doing this, I have generated over \$10 in donations to our foundation. It doesn't seem like much, but imagine the impact if all of our members did this! 2) Link your Fred Meyer rewards card to our foundation and earn a donation every time you shop at Fred Meyer.

Third, consider getting involved in organized dentistry. There are many opportunities to contribute new ideas to our local society and state association. You could express interest in serving on our executive committee or as a future delegate to the House of Delegates (which, for 2019, is coming up Sept. 26-28 in Spokane). WSDA also has many committees you may be interested in serving on, some of which only meet a few times a year. Please let me or Judy know if you need help finding the information needed to get involved in an area that suits you.

I hope I have provided some inspiration for your "school year" goal setting: 1 easy goal to help you, 1 easy goal to help our foundation, and 1 potentially challenging and expansive goal for the future.
